IT IS ORDERED that the Admiralty Marshal may at any time:-

- (a) take measures to preserve the ship (*give details*)

its machinery and equipment;
- (b) move the ship up to 5 miles within the limits of the port where it is lying under arrest, either for its safety or to comply with the requirements of the Port Authority;
- (c) supply the minimum victuals, domestic fuel and water necessary to avoid hardship to the crew.
